Scrabble judges play an essential role and are vital in creating a fun and memorable experience for the players by overseeing assigned teams and providing guidance on game rules. Most importantly, judges get to accept “enhancers” from players that will ultimately benefit programs at Literacy Advance!

What are the requirements for being a Scrabble Judge?

- Have a fun-loving and outgoing personality, with the ability to be firm when necessary, to enforce the rules of the competition.
- Have no physical limitations that prevent you from being on your feet for several hours or prohibit the ability to move freely and quickly through a restaurant-style set up.
- Attend **one** 2-hour Scrabble Judge training, either **Thursday, April 20, 5:30pm – 7:30pm** or **Saturday, April 22, 10am–12pm**.
- Attend Scrabble in the City on **May 3, 2017, 5pm – 10pm**.

What else do I need to know?

Scrabble in the City is a one-time event. It will be at Saint Arnold Brewing Company, 2000 Lyons Avenue, Houston, TX, 77020.

Volunteers need to provide their own transportation to the location. Free parking is provided.

Please wear comfortable shoes and the t-shirts that we will provide, along with dark jeans or khakis.

Dinner will be provided at Saint Arnold.
