What are the requirements for being a Scrabble volunteer?

- Have a fun-loving and outgoing personality, and be willing to share your volunteer experiences with guests.
- Tell us of any physical limitations you need us to consider when assigning tasks.
- Attend **one** 2-hour Scrabble Judge training, either **Thursday, April 20, 5:30pm – 7:30pm** or **Saturday, April 22, 10am–12pm**.
- Attend Scrabble in the City on **May 3, 2017, 5pm – 10pm**. Arrive at 5pm to help with set up, and stay to help break-down, until about 10pm.

What else do I need to know?

Scrabble in the City is a one-time event. It will be at Saint Arnold Brewing Company, 2000 Lyons Avenue, Houston, TX, 77020.

Volunteers need to provide their own transportation to the location. Free parking is provided.

Please wear comfortable shoes and the t-shirts that we will provide, along with dark jeans or khakis.

Dinner will be provided at Saint Arnold.
